Pavement – maximum percentage of pavement allowed is listed in section 8.1 of ordinance 2002-8.

If new pavement is in the public right-of-way there are specific standards which must be met. Standards are attached.

DRAINAGE REQUIREMENTS - Ordinance 94-11

The Village adopted certain drainage regulations with the intent to protect the well-being of neighboring property. These regulations may apply when additional impervious surface is part of a project.

NOISE/CONSTRUCTION ORDINANCE – Ordinance 98-2

- 1) No person, firm or corporation shall engage in any excavation, exterior construction, exterior building repair or renovation, tree removal activities, lawn care services for hire, or any other activity which creates excessive or unusual noise in a manner which disturbs the peace and quiet of the neighborhood during the following times:
 - a) Between the hours of 6 p.m. and 8 a.m.
 - b) On Sunday
 - c) On New Years’ Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.
- 2) Excepted from the provisions paragraph ‘A’ of this section are the following activities:
 - a) Emergency repair of public utilities conducted in the interest of public safety.
 - b) Emergency repair of structures conducted for the safety of the inhabitants thereof or for the protection of the contents thereof.

CONSTRUCTION COMMENCEMENT/COMPLETION – Ordinance 2002-8 Section 12.5

Construction must commence within 90 days of issuance of the permit. Once construction begins, a zoning permit is valid for a period of 12 months. Failure to commence construction within 90 days will invalidate the zoning permit.

INCOME TAX

All contractors AND residents making application for a permit with the Village of Ottawa Hills must be registered with our income tax department prior to issuance of a permit.

CLEAN WORK SITES

It is expected that the work site will be kept in a clean, organized manner.
